

## **Opus Newton**

Opus Newton is being built on the JCC Greater Boston campus in Newton, MA, and connected to 2Life's Coleman House by terraced spaces including a café; cultural arts, learning, and fitness areas; and patio gardens. Walking trails provide easy access to the JCC (discounted membership), Newton Community Farm, and Nahanton Park. Slated for residency mid-2025, the property will offer 174 apartments to middle-income older adults, each of whom commits to volunteering at least 10 hours per month. This approach helps reduce staffing and overhead costs while creating more opportunities for interpersonal interaction.
