

Leland House

Slated for occupancy in late 2024, Leland House is a beautiful new three-story building that pays homage to the former Leland Home, which served Waltham seniors for nearly 130 years. The highly efficient, sustainable, and resilient building has been designed to Passive House standards and will provide 68 affordable apartments for older adults. The first floor will incorporate a Village Center directly adjacent to the William F. Stanley Senior Center to facilitate the coordination of programming and services. The property is also just steps away from the transit-rich and thriving commercial corridor along Main Street.
